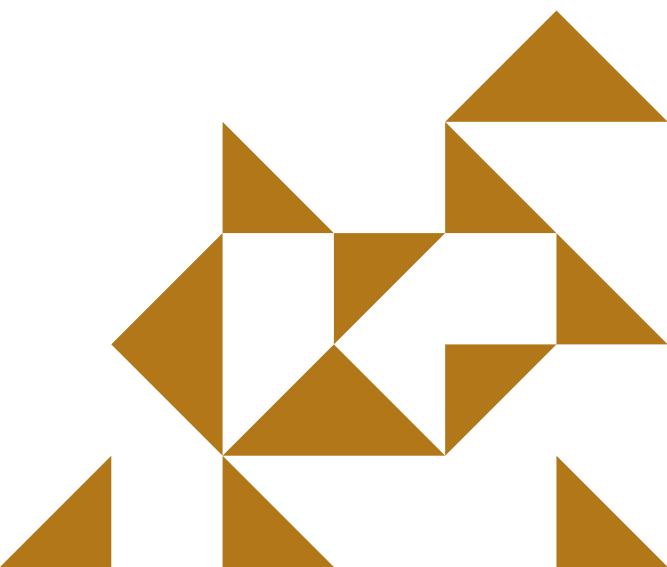

Dear participants of the Annual Congress 2025 of the SSRE and SGL

Under the motto «Education in a Diverse and Complex World», we would like to welcome you to the Lucerne University of Teacher Education.

Diversity is a cornerstone of a pluralistic society. Contemporary educational processes must foster opportunities for learning and participation that accommodate the individual abilities and needs of all people. To achieve this, it is essential to consider the various dimensions of diversity and their intersectional interplay within the complex dynamic between difference and equality. 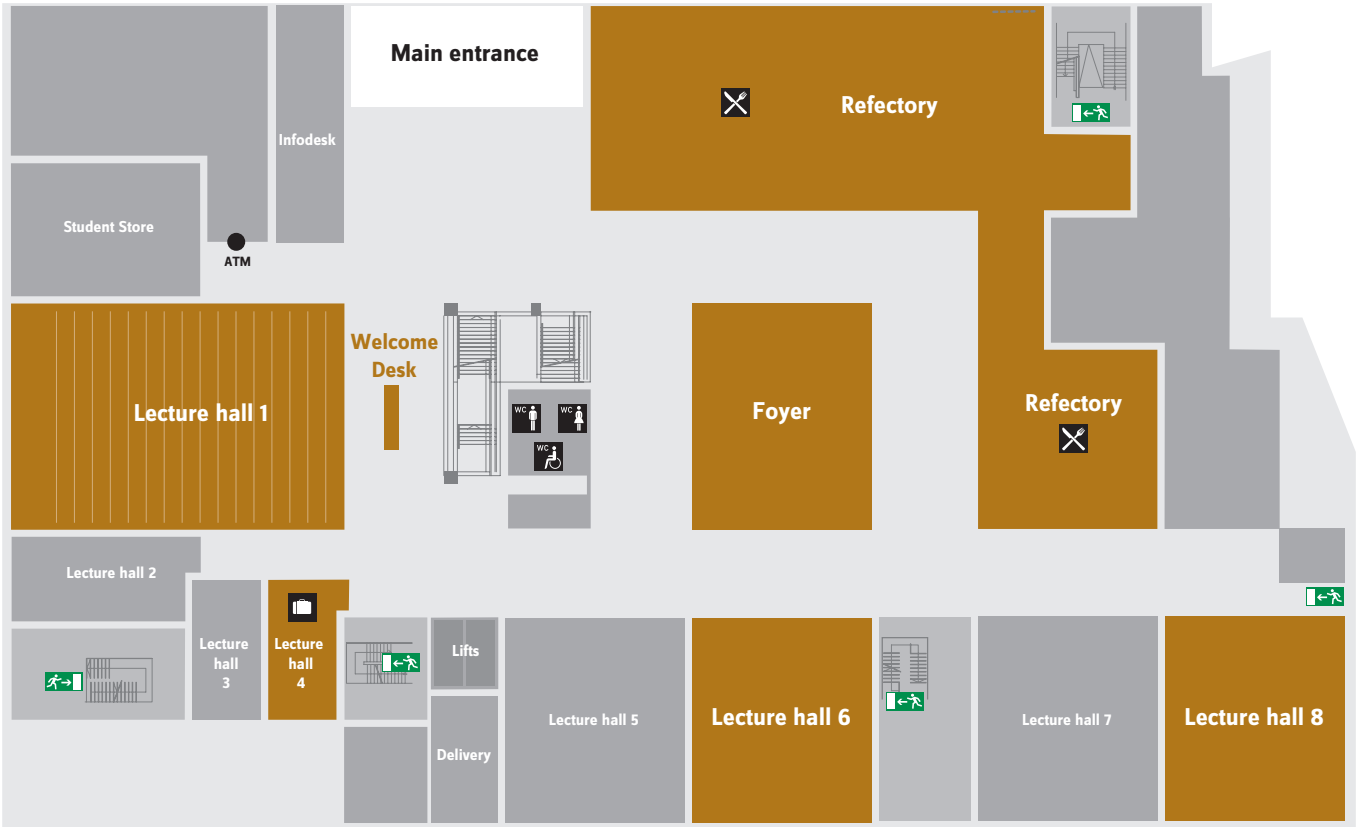

name badge (vegan or meat).

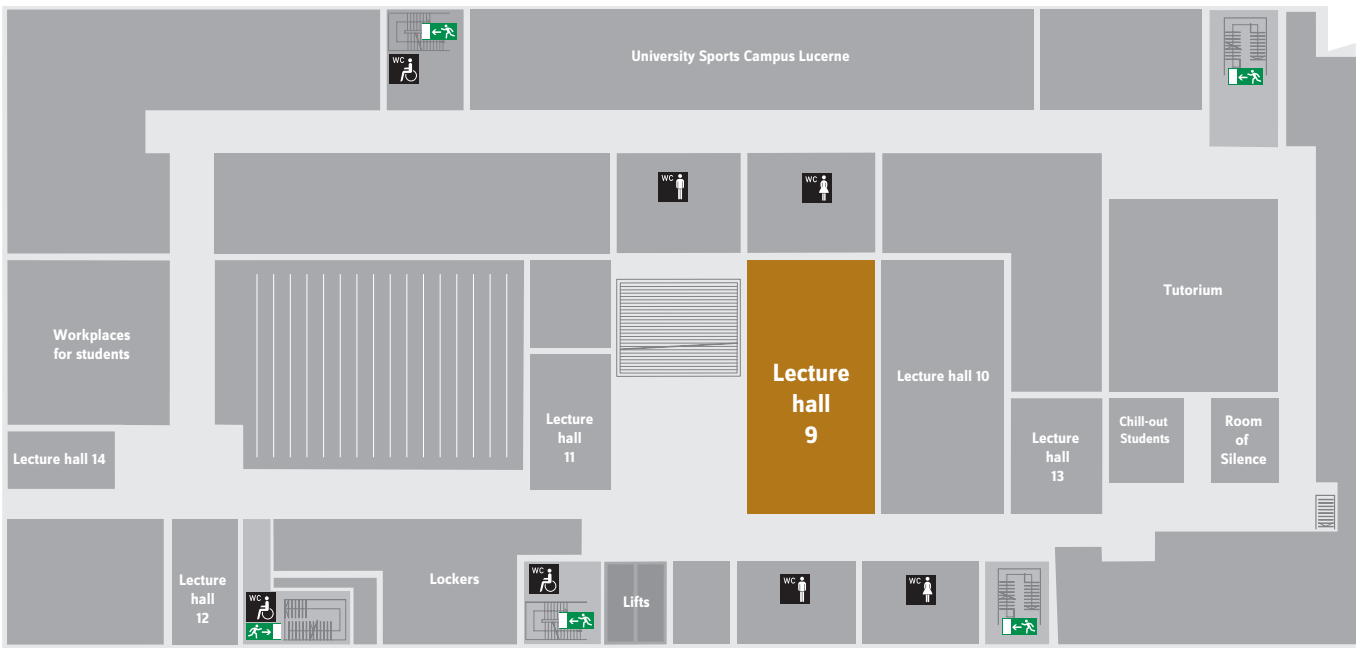
The vegan menu is both gluten and lactose-free. However,
